




- Non-governmental, non-political, non-profit institution established in 1991

### **Teamig for Excellence**

January 2013: white paper "Teaming for Excellence: Building High-Quality Research Across Europe Through Partnership"

- Creation of centers of excellence in member states that are lagging behind in research, set up as joint ventures with excellent partners from other member states
- Signed by research organizations: CNRS, CSIC, CNR, Institute Pasteur, Max Planck Society etc.



### **Teamig for Excellence**

December 2013: Horizon 2020 work program "Spreading Excellence and Widening Participation 2014–2015"

- Promoting the excellence in science
- Closing the innovation gap
- Plans for creation of new (or upgrading of existing)
  centres of excellence in low-performing member states



# Composite Indicator of Research Excellence

- The share of highly cited publications in all publications
  where at least one of the authors has an affiliation in a given
  country;
- Number of top scientific universities and public research organizations in a country per million population;
- Patent applications per million population;
- Total value of ERC grants received divided by public R&D performed by the higher education and government sectors;

Teaming for Excellence for MSs below 70% of the EU27 average of the Composite Indicator on Research Excellence (CIRE)



### **Teaming for Excellence**

To reach a higher level of the Composite Indicator of Research Excellence:

- Efforts in rising the share of the best papers
- Creation of top research centres
- Rising the number of patents
- Increasing chances in ERC competitions

- Continue scientific partnership with new center "Excellence breeds excellence" (new grants or projects)
